FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE TO GRADUATING SENIORS.

This year's graduating seniors who wish to apply for financial assistance must have a 3.0 or higher GPA and must complete an application. Proof of acceptance from the prospective college, university or other institution of higher learning must accompany the application. Applications are available on CAFCI website - www.cafcipbc.org, our office and from all high school guidance counselors.

Student Assistance Eligibility Requirements:

Applicant must:

- Be a resident of Palm Beach County, Florida
- Currently attend high school in Palm Beach County, and is expecting to graduate within one year
- Demonstrate an interest in Caribbean-American affairs
- Provide a completed application postmarked no later than March 15, 2014
- Provide an acceptance letter from a college/university (this must accompany the application)
- Be available for an interview on April 5, 2014
- Be able to attend a Presentation of Awards Ceremony, if selected, on May 3, 2014 at 7:00 p.m.
