Student Assistance Program Awards Application: Graduating students interested in applying for financial assistance must have at least a 3.0 GPA and demonstrate continuous academic success through their high school tenure. Applicants must show that they have participated in school and community activities, and must also show an interest in the Caribbean community. The monetary assistance is awarded to students who have been accepted into a college, university or other accredited institution of higher learning. Proof of acceptance from the prospective institution must accompany the application.

Eligibility Requirements (NEW APPLICATION DEADLINE: March 17, 2017)

Applicant must:

- Be a resident of Palm Beach County, Florida
- Currently attend high school in Palm Beach County, and will graduate May, 2017
- Demonstrate an interest in Caribbean-American affairs
- Provide a completed application postmarked no later than March 17, 2017 (NOTE NEW DEADLINE)
- Provide an acceptance letter from an accredited college, personal statement and two (2) letters of recommendation
- Be available for an interview on April 1, 2017
- Be able to attend the presentation of awards ceremony on May 6, 2017 at 6 pm, if selected,

Saturday, March 11, 2017 at 3 - 11 pm South Florida Fairgrounds





Last month, we investigated leads for two pieces of land and one commercial building. Unfortunately, these leads did not yield positive results. Our biggest hurdle continues to be financing. We have not been able to secure a grant or identify a program that we can execute that will provide grant funding. Commercial loans were not an option and owner financing was not available. We will continue to investigate availability of grants to fund programs using

a CAFCI owned facility and creative ways to obtain financing. Despite the disappointment, let us continue to be patient and hopeful as we work towards finding a home for CAFCI.
